

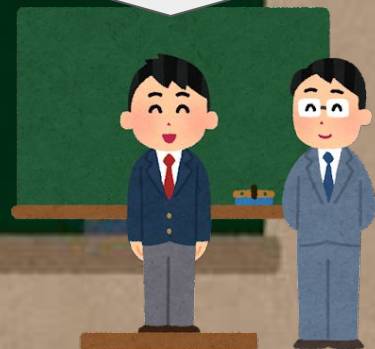
Daily English Conversation Greeting



What is greeting(問候)?

A greeting is something **friendly** (adv.友好的) that you say when you meet **someone**(n.某人).

There are **formal**(adj.正式的) and **informal**(adj.非正式的) greetings.

Formal greeting

When meeting someone under formal **situation** (n.情況) such as in a **meeting** (n.會議), you can use formal greetings.

Good morning, teacher.
(早上好)

Good morning.

Nice to meet you.
(很高興見到你)

Nice to meet you
too.

How are you doing?
(你好嗎?)



Formal greeting dialogue

Good morning!
How are you doing?

I'm doing well. And
you? (我很好, 你呢?)

I'm fine. Thank you for
asking. (謝謝你的慰問)

See you.



Informal greeting

You can talk to your friends and family by using informal greetings.

Hello/Hi.

How's it going?
(怎樣了?)

How's your day going?
(你今天過得怎樣?)

Fine / Great
(很好/很棒)

It's a good day.
(美好的一天)



Informal greeting dialogue

How's going?

Great, and you?



It's a good day.
I'm feeling fine.
(我感覺很好)

See you later.
(回頭見)



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
