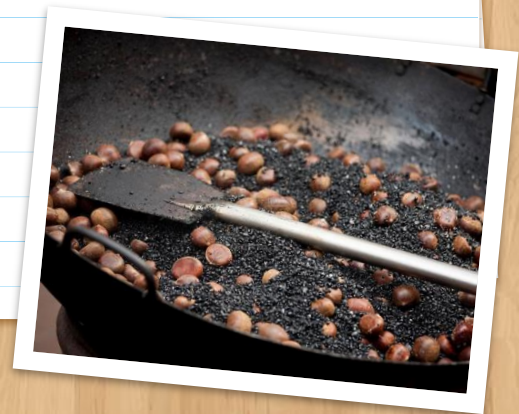
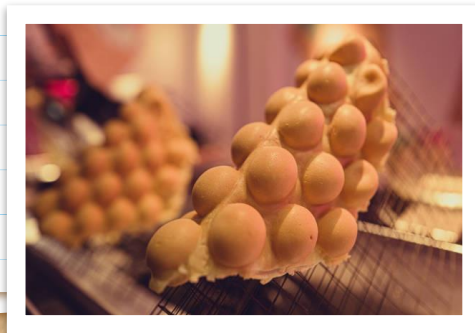
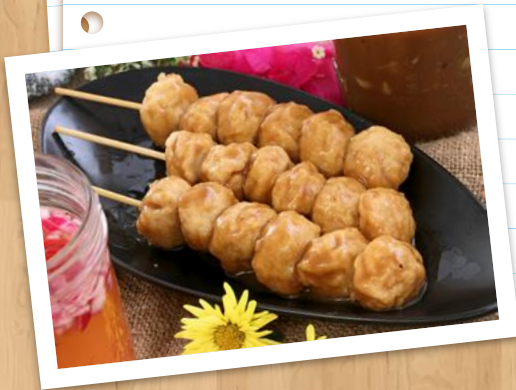

'**How much are...**?' for **two items or more**.

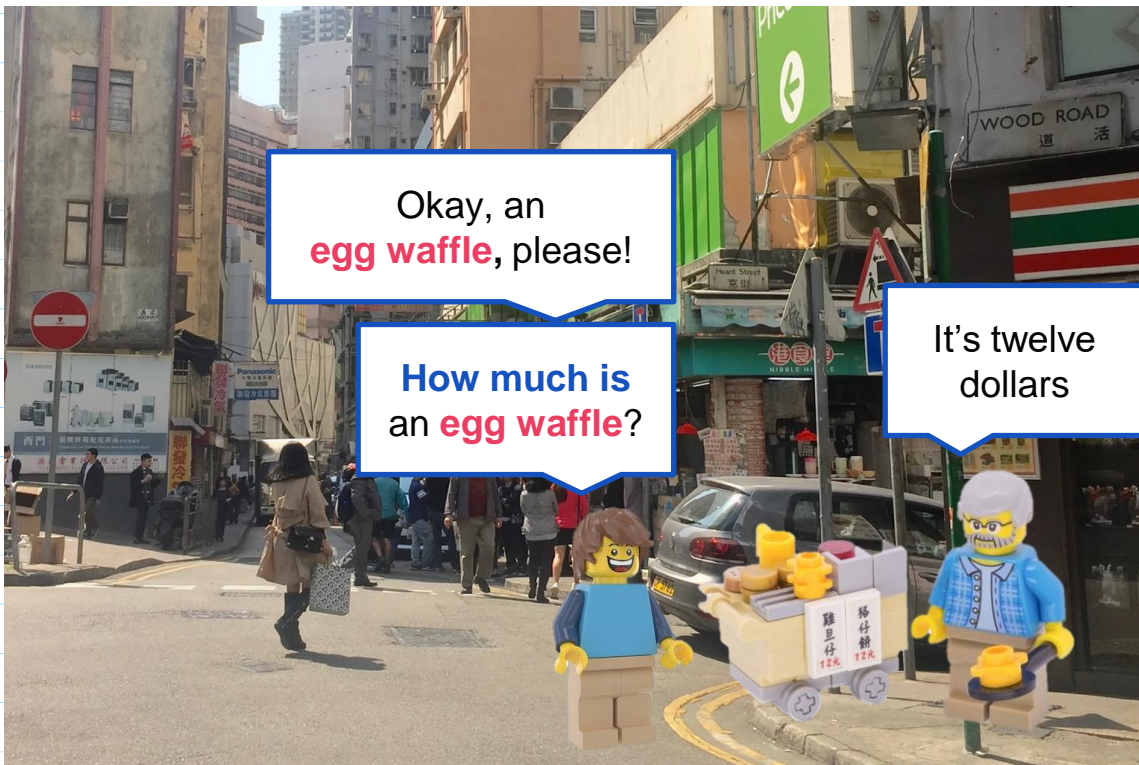

an **egg waffle**?

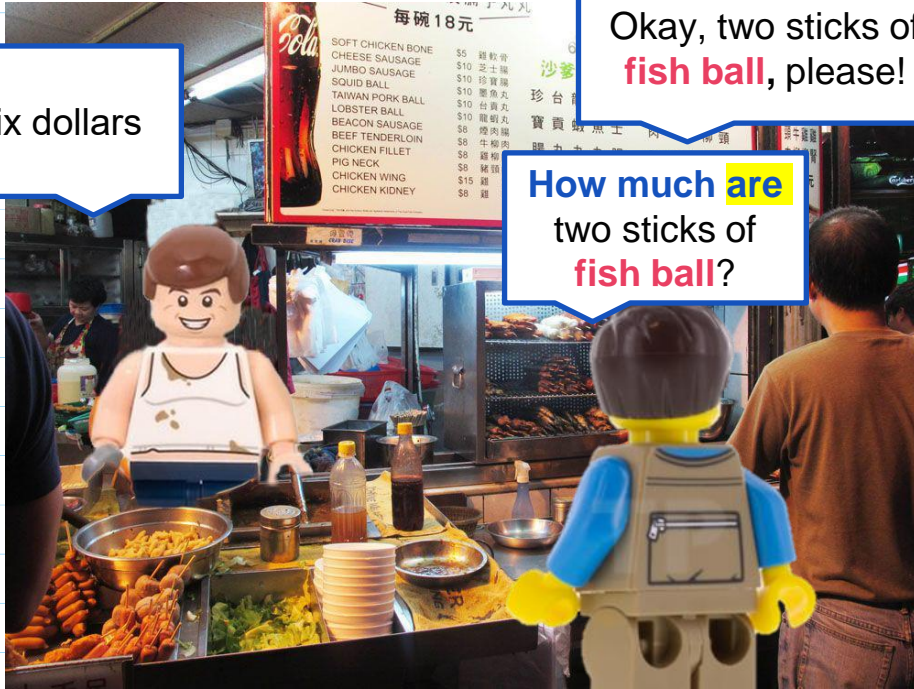
It's twelve
