### (四) 每日家課及考試範圍登錄於學校網頁

### (五) 校曆

學校行事曆已預印在學生手冊中及上載於學校網頁,校曆亦已列明所有固定假期。如學生需要告事假(包括參加公開試),必須於兩個上課天前遞交請假信,待訓育組批准。

### (六) 學校升留級政策及中六級畢業要求

為貫徹本校德智並重之教育理念,校方在制訂學生的升留級準則時,除了考慮學生的學業成績外,亦會將其行為操守納入考量。為鼓勵同學不斷求進,本校已重新審視並修改有關學生留級、試升及畢業的要求及準則,詳情如下:

- 學業成績 學年平均分須達 30 分或以上
- 出席率 學年平均出席率須達 90% 或以上
- 品德及操行 等級為 B- 或以上,學習態度良好

### 1. 中一至中五級升留級準則:

- (1) 若學生未能符合以上任何一項條件,將被列入「考慮留級」之列。
- (2) 若學生的學習態度或策略欠佳,導致未達學校升級要求,該學生須在暑假期間完成「暑期成長增值班」,且達校方要求,方可酌情試升。
- (3) 凡試升者,如於參與試升班級期間,學科成績或操行仍不能達到學校要求,學校 有權飭令該生降級或由校方協助下轉介至其他合適學校升學。

#### 2. 中六級畢業要求

- (1) 中六級同學須符合以上三項要求,方可獲學校頒發畢業證書。
- (2) 若學生未能符合以上任何一項條件,則獲校方頒發修業證書。

學生如因特殊原因而未能達到以上要求,可向校方申請酌情處理,惟學生及其家長必須向校方提供足夠理據及呈交相關證明文件,校方方會考慮其申請。至於是否接納申請,校方持有最終決定權。

### (十四)健康校園計劃

為促進青少年的健康發展,本校獲禁毒基金撥款資助,與童軍知友社合作推行健康校園計劃。健康校園計劃分為兩部分:第一部分為「健康校園抗毒活動」(內容:不同時段、分級別舉行各項活動),此計劃希望透過小組活動及訓練營等活動,加強他們面對成長挑戰的能力,所有訓練活動均免費參加,有關家長信將於稍後派發。健康校園計劃的第二部分為「校園測檢計劃」,此計劃可鞏固沒有吸食毒品的學生繼續遠離毒品的決心,即使有朋輩引誘他們嘗試吸毒,會更堅決說「不」,從而預防毒品在校園蔓延;另外本計劃亦可觸發吸食毒品的學生(尤其是初期接觸毒品的學生) 戒毒和求助的動機,同時為希望走出毒海的學生提供適切的支援服務。

有關計劃簡介詳情如下:

- 1. 参加本計劃純屬自願。家長及學生可參閱網上「校園測檢計劃」守則 (網址:https://www.nd.gov.hk/tc/HSP.html),請家長與學生討論後,再填寫「校園測檢 計劃」同意書以表達 閣下及學生的意願。
- 2. 於計劃推行期間,校外專責隊伍(童軍知友社)會不定期到訪學校,並從參與學生中 每學年隨機抽選最少 20% 進行測檢。
- 3. 測檢過程:校長/或任何代表其行事的指定教職員通知被抽中的學生,並指 示他們前往收集樣本的地點。校外專責隊伍會與有關學生進行甄別面談,向他簡介收集頭髮/尿液樣本的目的。有關學生可以在廁格內提供樣本,以保障個人私隱。樣本收集袋會貼上樣本代碼,樣本不會貼附任何可識別個人身分的資料,以確保資料保密和保障私隱。有關樣本會由收集樣本者送交政府化驗所。非必要的樣本會立即妥善地銷毀。
- 4. 抽中的學生也可即場:
  - 甲、 在沒有進行測試的情況下,自行轉介參加童軍知友社的支援計劃;
  - 乙、 拒絕接受測檢;或
  - 丙、 撤回參與同意書。
- 5. 政府化驗所將會準備兩份相同的化驗所測試結果報告,正本及副本分別由學校和獲校 外專責隊伍授權的人員領取。校長/或任何代表其行事的指定教職員將通知被抽中的 學生家長/監護人化驗所的測試結果。

(2) If a student applies for a leave due to personal reasons and cancels the lunch box he or she ordered, parents or the student should notify the class teacher and complete an online cancellation form (https://forms.gle/oEzQ6pmdShqZe1u18) three working days before the request for leave so that the meal can be returned. Otherwise, the request for meal return will be invalid. Upon valid request, the supplier will automatically deduct the amount from the payment in the following month.



- (3) If the Education Bureau announces the class suspension before 8:30am or the class is suspended due to weather conditions, the supplier will postpone the lunch for that day to the following day and provide lunch boxes as scheduled for the remaining days.

- Behaviour and Conduct Grade B– or above with good learning attitude

#### 1. S1 to 5 Promotion and Repeat Criteria:

- (1) Students who fail to meet any of the above conditions will be included in the "Consideration for Repeating".
- (2) If the student's learning attitude or strategy is not good enough to meet the school's promotion requirements, the student must complete the "Summer Class for Growth and Value-Addedness" during the summer vacation and meet the school's requirements before promotion on trial at the school's discretion.
- (3) For students who are promoted on trial, if their academic performance or conduct still fails to meet the school's requirements during the period of taking the test for promotion on trial, the school has the right to order the student to a lower form or helps refer the student to another suitable school for further education.

#### 2. S6 Graduation Requirements

- (1) S6 students must meet the above three requirements in order to be awarded a graduation certificate issued by the school.
- (2) If the student fails to meet any of the above conditions, the school will issue a completion certificate. If students fail to meet the above requirements due to special reasons, they can apply to the school for discretionary treatment, but the students and their parents must provide sufficient justifications and submit relevant supporting documents to the school, and the school will consider their application. As for whether to accept the application, the school has the final decision.

#### (8) Personal Data Processing Statement for Students and Parents or Guardians

The school is committed to handling all personal data in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance. Personal data about students and parents or guardians are processed as follows:

- 1. The personal data of students will be used for student registration, student records or to provide reference for counseling services, while the personal data of parents or guardians will be mainly used for communication or data verification;
- 2. The personal data of students collected by the school will only be disclosed to the school staff, the IMC and other relevant government departments or agencies and will not be used for the above purposes with other agencies. If the school needs to use the personal data of the student/parent or guardian for other purposes, the school will seek the consent of the parent or guardian in advance;
- 3. The school will strengthen communication with the community through different media such as webpages, leaflets, publications, etc., which may include the names, classes, personal awards, photos or video clips of students of the school, etc.;
- 4. In accordance with the data protection principles in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, subjects who have provided personal data have the right to access and correct their personal data. To access and correct personal data, please submit a written request to the Principal;
- 5. The public areas of the school are equipped with a video recording system, which is only used for internal security purposes, but it may also collect students' appearance and activities. All recordings are generally stored for a maximum of four weeks and then deleted.

#### (9) <u>Matters concerning "School Textbook Assistance and Student Travel Subsidy"</u>

Regarding the application for the "School Textbook Assistance and Student Travel Subsidy 2024-2025", if the applicant did not receive the textbook subsidy in the previous school year and has completed the online electronic application form in May this year or has mailed the application form directly to the Student Financial Assistance Agency, the Student Financial Assistance Office will report the result in late August. It will be mailed directly to the applicant. Parents who are assessed as eligible to apply for financial assistance will be issued a "Certificate of Eligibility" for each child in school. Please return the certificate to the School Office on or before <u>9 September (Monday)</u> so that the school can verify it and send it to the Student Financial Assistance Office. If parents receive the Certificate of Eligibility <u>after the start of classes</u>, they are also required to return the Certificate of Eligibility to the school <u>within two weeks after the issue date</u>.

#### (14) Healthy School Program

In order to stimulate the health development of young people, our School has received funding from the Beat Drugs Fund (BDF) and cooperated with the Scout Association of Hong Kong – The Friends of Scouting to implement the Healthy School Program. The Program is divided into two parts. The first part is "Healthy School Anti-Drug Activities" (content: various activities are arranged for students in different forms at different sessions), aiming to strengthen students' abilities to face growth challenges through group activities and training camps. All training activities are free of charge, and School Notice will be distributed accordingly later. The second part of the Healthy School Program is the "School Drug Testing Scheme", which is to strengthen the determination of students who have not taken drugs to keep staying away from drugs. Even when faced with peer pressure to experiment with drugs, students will steadfastly respond with a resounding "NO" effectively curbing the proliferation of drug use on campus. Furthermore, this program aims to motivate students, particularly those newly introduced to drugs, to break free from their substance dependency and seek assistance. Simultaneously, it aspires to offer essential support to those students determined to overcome their addiction.

Details of the Program are shown as follows:

- 1. Participation in the Program is voluntary. Parents and students can refer to the guidelines for the "School Drug Testing Scheme" online (website: https://www.nd.gov.hk/tc/HSP.html). Parents should discuss with the children before completing the "School Drug Testing Scheme" Consent Form to express your and your child's preference.
- 2. During the implementation of the Scheme, the school drug testing team (the Friends of Scouting) will visit the School from time to time and randomly select at least 20% of the participating students for testing every school year.
- 3. Testing process: The principal/or any designated staff member acting on his or her behalf shall notify the selected students and direct them to the location where the sample will be collected. The school drug testing team will conduct a screening interview with the students concerned and brief them on the purpose of collecting hair/urine samples. The students concerned can provide samples in the toilet cubicles to protect personal privacy. The sample collection bag will be labeled with a sample code, and no personally identifiable information will be attached to the sample to ensure data confidentiality and protect privacy. The samples will be sent to the Government Laboratory by the people in charge of sample collection, while non-essential samples will be promptly and properly destroyed.
- 4. Students who are selected can also:
  - A. refer himself or herself to the Friends of Scouting's support program without participating in the test;
  - B. refuse to attend the test; or
  - C. withdraw his or her consent to participate in the Scheme.
- 5. The Government Laboratory will prepare two identical laboratory test result reports. The original and the copy will be collected by the School and the authorized personnel of the school drug testing team respectively. The principal/or any designated staff member acting on his or her behalf will notify the parents/guardians of the selected students of the laboratory test results.

Our School will distribute the "School Drug Testing Scheme" Consent Form" to all students later. Please discuss the relevant matters with your child, indicate your child's preference, and ask your child to fold and seal the signed consent form and return it to the class teacher. This Scheme has educational significance and is important to your child. It is hence hoped that you will actively support it and take this opportunity to discuss drug-related issues with your child in order to strengthen your child's determination to stay away from drugs. #### (19) Application for Bringing Mobile Phone back to School and Using the Mobile Phone Storage Locker

Our school has always encouraged students to be with wisdom and compassion as their learning goals, and does not encourage students to bring mobile phones back to school so as not to affect their learning mood. Students are also prohibited from using and displaying mobile phones within the campus. Understanding that parents are concerned about their children's return to school, our school allows students to apply to the school to bring their mobile phones back to school. - 3. Students in S1 to 3 who are approved to carry mobile phones must hand the phone to the class teacher during roll call every morning. The phone will be returned by the class teacher on the last teaching day or after school. The class teacher is only responsible for storing the phone for the student and is not responsible for any scratches or damage.
- 4. Students in S4 to 6 can apply to the school to use mobile phone storage cabinets. The rules are as follows:
  - 4.1 Students must turn off their mobile phones before entering the school and store them in designated mobile phone storage cabinets before 8:15am (morning session) and 2:10pm (afternoon session). inside and lock the storage cabinet.
  - 4.2 Students must bring their own locks and are not allowed to use combination locks. They must also submit a backup key to the class teacher if it is needed urgently.
  - 4.3 The school office staff will lock the locker doors at 8:30am and 2:30pm. If students return to school after the above time, students are asked to hand in their mobile phones to the school office staff, which will keep them and pick them up after school.
  - 4.4 If students need to contact their parents during school, they can borrow a school phone from the school office.

#### **Security and Reminders:**

- 1. There is a 24-hour CCTV surveillance system near the storage cabinets. If any theft or damage occurs, the school will do its best to assist in the investigation. However, the school will not be responsible for any losses.
- 2. The opening hours of the mobile phone storage locker are as follows:
  - 7:30am to 8:30am; and
  - 1:00pm to 2:30pm; and
  - 4:00pm to 5:15pm.
- 3. Students must store and retrieve their mobile phones by themselves and are not allowed to let others do it for them.
- 4. Students are not allowed to transfer their mobile phone lockers to others, nor are they allowed to store other people's belongings on their behalf.
- 5. Students should keep their mobile phone locks and keys carefully. If any property is lost or damaged, students are responsible for their own property losses and the school will not be held responsible.
- 6. In order to monitor whether students have complied with the above rules, teachers of our school can open the mobile phone storage cabinet for inspection in the presence of parents or guardians of students. Relevant persons are requested to cooperate with the school.
